2002

Purchased our first robotic welding machine, which vastly increased the production output of our manufactured systems.





Landmark Projects

Quay Quarter Tower, Sydney NSW

This innovative building design required a rope access system that allowed effective facade maintenance without impacting the archtechture of the tower. RAPTOR Rope Access Rail did just that, providing an unobtrusive design and easy facade rope access use. RAPTOR Rail was also installed in the internal stair voids, for maintenance on internal facades.

Junction Oval, St Kilda VIC

This project required an effective access solution up to and around multiple roofs for maintenance and a means of entry for television film crews. VCCC Building, Melbourne VIC

The new cancer research hospital required a large majority of SAYFA products for access solutions and safety during maintenance at heights. ALTO Step Ladders, KOMBI Modular Platforms, SENTRY Guardrails, PACE600 Walkways, TRAVEL8 Static Lines and 3SIXTY Anchors were all installed on the exterior of the building, and Multiple VISTA Fold Down Ladders were installed inside. RAPTOR Rails were also installed to provide building facade access.

Victorian Heart Hospital, Clayton VIC

The new hospital situated on the Monash University Campus will be Australia's first specialist cardiac hospital. Multiple height safety and rope access systems were needed to provide safe work at heights and facade maintenance. RAPTOR Rails were installed on the exterior of the building. With low visual impact and the ability of the system to be shaped to follow the curves of the building design, it was the perfect solution.
